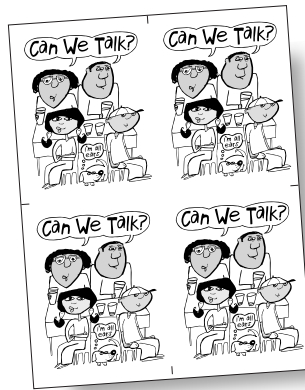


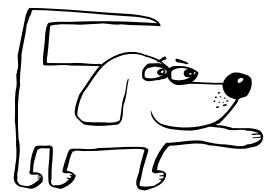
Promotional postcards



The “Can We Talk?” postcards have many uses. You can print information about an upcoming workshop series on the back side and send them to parents. You can use them for announcements of special “Can We Talk?” events or for thank-you notes. You may even wish to give workshop attendees a set of postcards and encourage them to send a note to another parent, telling them about “Can We Talk?”

Directions for use

Decide what kind of information you want on the back of the “Can We Talk?” postcard. Write your text, then lay it out in four sections, just as we did on the front (each postcard is 4 1/4" x 5 1/2"). Photocopy the postcards double-sided on heavy paper. Then cut each sheet into quarters. Before making hundreds of copies, always make a “test” postcard, to make sure that the back matches the front. (See postcards on p. 77.)



Postcards stand out in a pile of junk mail. And they fit well into tight budgets for mailing. To trim your budget even further, ask a local printer to donate the printing.

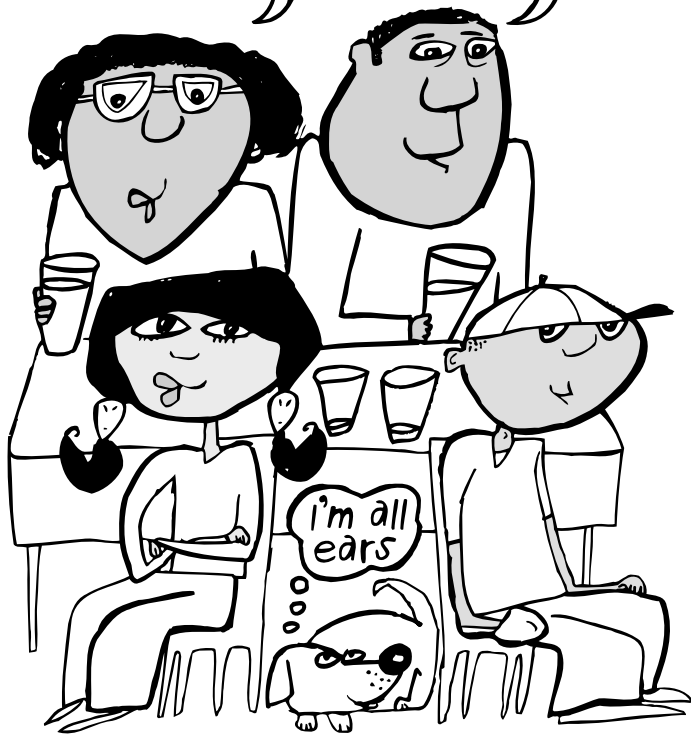
