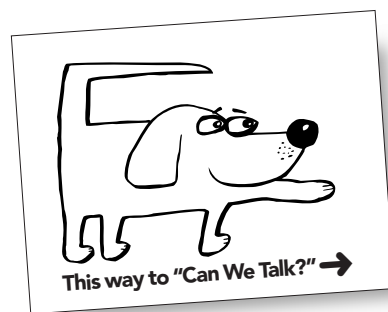


## Signs

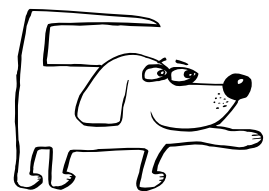


The “Can We Talk?” signs are a small but important part of the toolkit. For many parents, coming to the “Can We Talk?” workshop may be the first time they have been to their child’s school. To make parents feel welcome (and keep them from wandering down unfamiliar hallways), use the signs to point the way to the workshop. Consider where the workshop attendees probably will be

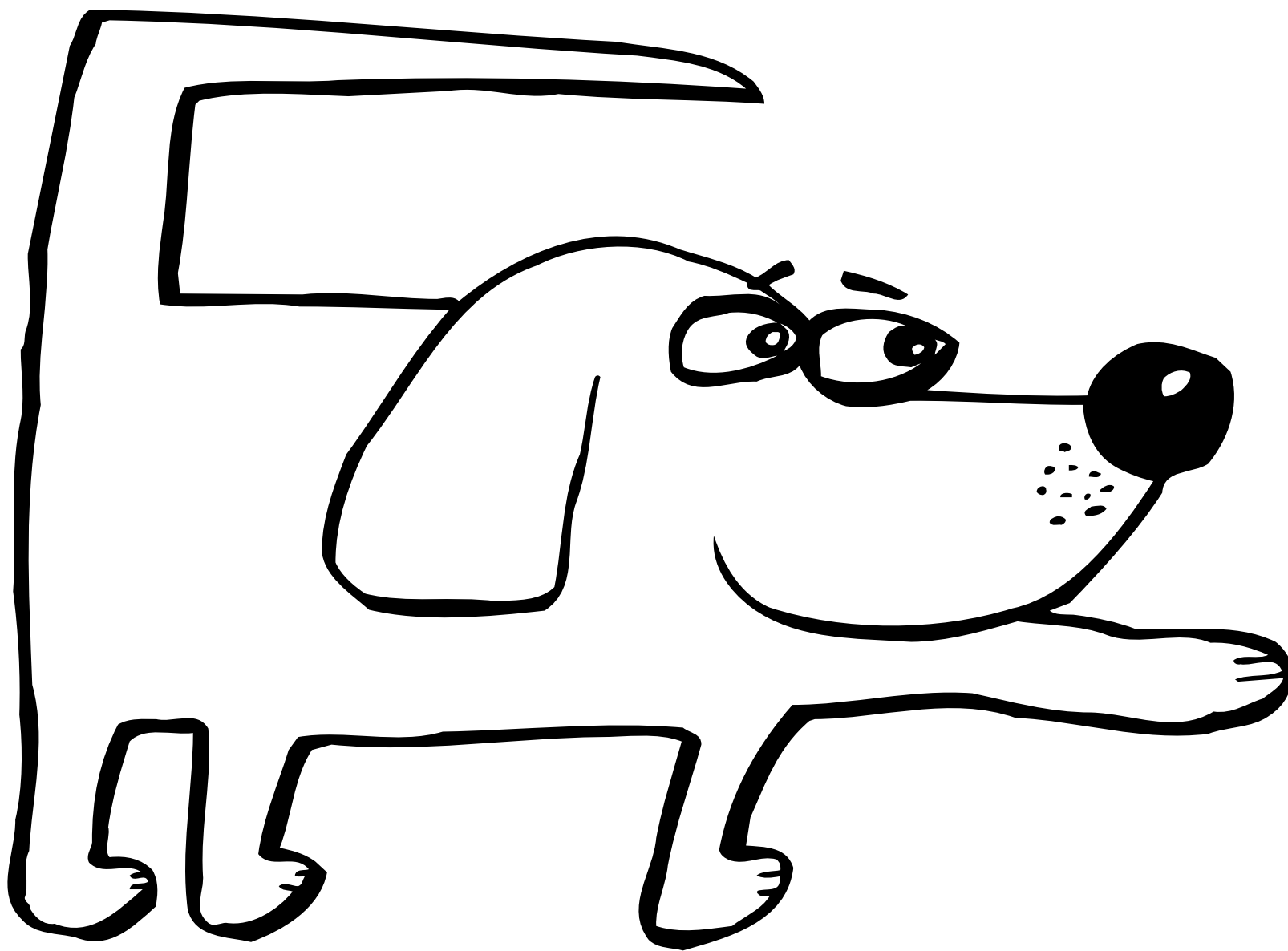
coming from (via car, bus, or on foot) and place a sign at every entrance to the building and at every turn.

### Directions for use

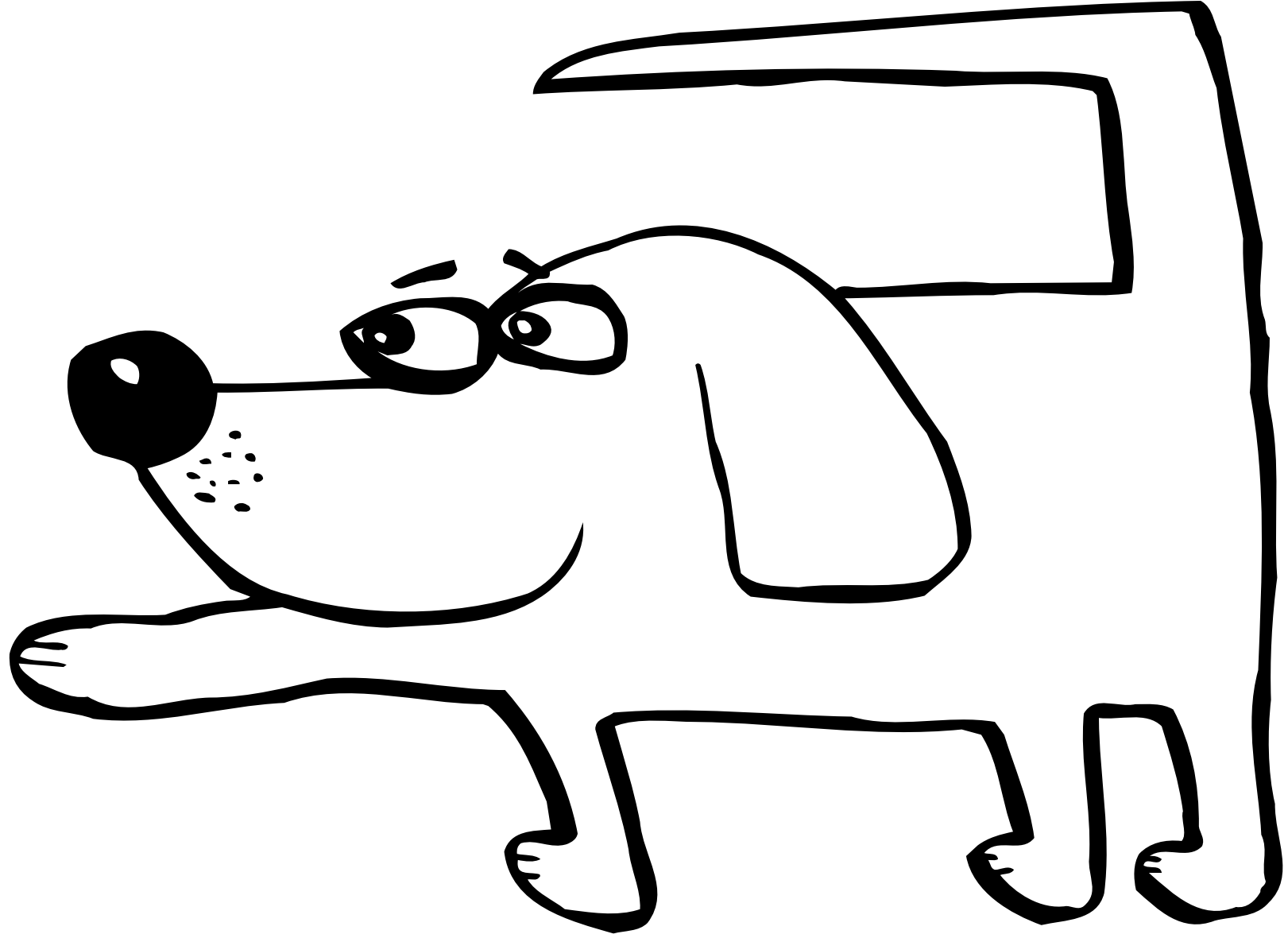
